Tabs (eg., in Preferences)

Ctrl+J	Next tab
Ctrl+K	Previous tab
Ctrl+[n]	Nth tab (leftmost tab is 1)

Buttons

Enter	Press the button
↓	Display pop-up menu for the button

Pop-up Menus

↓	Move to the next item
↑	Move to the previous item
Enter	Select the current item
Esc	Dismiss the menu
→	Show sub-menu of current item
←	Hide the sub-menu

Lists

Space	Select next item
J	Select next item
K	Select the previous item
Ctrl+A	Select all visible items
Home	Select the first item
End	Select the last item
Ctrl+`	Select/Unselect the focused item
Enter	Double-click the selected item
,	Show context menu on item
Shift+,	Show context menu on item
Ctrl+Enter	Show context menu on item
Shift+↓	Add next item to the selection
Shift+↑	Add previous item to the selection
Ctrl+↓	Focus on next item w/o selecting
Ctrl+↑	Focus on previous item w/o selecting

Enter	Save changes (same as "OK")
Space	Save changes (same as "OK")
Esc	Cancel changes (same as "Cancel")

→	Focus on the next button
